

I know we are weary of COVID-19. But, it is here and we must deal with it. We need to remember that God has been so good to us as a church throughout all of this. We only missed 4 Sundays of worship through this. And, since we began having church outdoors, we have not missed one Sunday or had to come inside. God has blessed us with a run of 24 weeks in a row so far. Going forward, here is some information you need to know about how we will be proceeding in the coming days. This is the Reader's Digest (condensed) version of what we published in the September 27 bulletin. We will also have the comprehensive version on the website (www.dekalbchristian.com).

We plan to continue to meet outdoors through the end of October. Sunday, November 1, we will begin meeting indoors again. There are four options for worship when we make the transition to indoors worship.

1. Fellowship Hall. We are working on installing a live video feed from the auditorium to the fellowship hall. This will make it possible to have the worship service broadcast onto the screen in the fellowship hall. The following is important information for those who will choose to worship in the fellowship hall. (You will need to consult the more comprehensive instructions if you desire to worship in the Fellowship Hall.)

2. Auditorium. Masks will be optional (please consult the more comprehensive instructions to prepare for worship)

3. A third option for worship is available. You can stay in your vehicle and listen on FM 104.7. Just park between the deck and the air conditioning units on the South side and we will bring you a bulletin, communion, etc... and will put your offering into one of the offering boxes for you. (Note to all: please keep the parking area just south of the Fellowship Hall for in-car worshippers only. Thank you!)

4. A fourth option for worship is to wait until Sunday evening when the worship service is made available online through facebook, Rumble.com, and Youtube (sermon only).

We will continue to offer SuperChurch downstairs. We ask that only children ages 3 through 6th Grade attend (unless otherwise asked to provide assistance) to help with proper social distancing.

We will continue to begin our worship at 10:00 AM, and will only be providing our Worship Service at this time.

We ask that you do not enter if you have symptoms of COVID-19, including an elevated temperature, coughing, sneezing, shortness of breath, or any other symptoms, or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19.

The leadership of De Kalb Christian Church thanks you all again for your cooperation, patience, and positivity during our time of worship outside.
